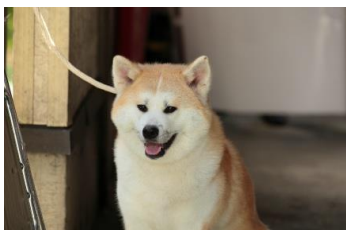

The Akita Dog Museum is Japan's only Akita Kennel Club museum. There are plenty of resources about Akita dogs, a natural treasure, on display. In front of the hall is a bronze Homesick Hachiko statue, which depicts Hachiko in his final years (around the age of 12), looking up at the sky above Shibuya Station as he remembers his home of Odate.

These Inaniwa udon noodles are made with faithful adherence to the traditional method in a pristine workshop with no machinery whatsoever. Watch as the noodles are crafted using a family secret technique!

Kawatsura lacquerware experience (No. 97)



Gold lacquer work such as chinkin and maki-e has been used in a range of craft products since ancient times; with this experience, you can try this craft technique for yourself. Decorating lacquerware with lustrous gold brings out the beauty of the lacquer itself. Chinkin: Using a blade called a kanna, a pattern is etched into the surface of the lacquerware, which is then filled in with raw lacquer and decorated with gold. Maki-e: A pattern is painted in lacquer following a preliminary sketch, and gold dust or colored powder is then applied to the lacquer.
